Jewellery

For Health and Safety reasons the wearing of jewellery is not allowed in school. Children do not need to wear neck chains, bracelets, pendants etc. The only exception to this rule is the wearing of studs in ears (not hoops or earrings larger than a small stud), though it is important to point out to parents that even these pose a health and safety risk and must be removed for PE. In PE children should not wear any jewellery (including earrings) which should be removed by them and replaced by them. Teachers cannot take the responsibility for this. Thank you for your support.
