### Year 4 Class of the Week

This week we've been learning about the layers of the ocean in geography. 5 There are layers altogether: the sunlight zone, twilight zone, midnight lower zone midnight zone and the trenches.



We have also created some artwork linked to the

layers. We had to mix colours to create different shades of the sea. Our artwork is perspective art which means that it is like we are looking up from the abyss at the different layers of the ocean.

Here are our top 3 fun facts that we have learnt this week:

- Most animals that live in the trenches are blind.
- There are lots of different species of marine life that live in the abyss. Some of them are called: sea spiders, sea pigs and blob fish!
- The temperature drops the deeper under the sea you go. This is why most animals we know and can see at the beach are in the sunlight zone because it is warmer. This zone is 0-200m under the surface of the ocean.

### **Celebration Circles**

As you know from the newsletter last week, we have arranged outdoor class 'Celebration Circles'. This will be one class bubble at a time during specific afternoon slots from 2:30pm - 3pm (see dates overleaf).
