Celebration Circles

We have arranged outdoor class 'Celebration Circles'. This will be one class bubble at a time during specific afternoon slots from 2:30pm - 3pm (see dates overleaf). **We provided a form through Parentmail to confirm the name and contact details of the adult (one) who is attending. For organisational and COVID measures purposes, if you do not complete the form, we will assume that you are not attending.**



To enable this to be safe and successful, we require necessary control measures.

- Details of the adult attending via Parentmail **before** the afternoon.
- The adult attending must remain socially distanced from other children and adults throughout the afternoon, including arrival and departure.
- Entrance will be through the current socially distanced school car park (as is the procedure for school drop off and collection).
- If it is necessary to bring younger siblings, they must remain within the allocated socially distanced space.
- You are welcome to bring a blanket to sit upon if you wish.
- **Toilet facilities will not be available.**

During the Celebration Circle session, the children will share their favourite learning.

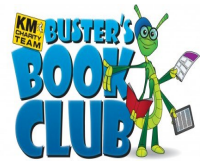
