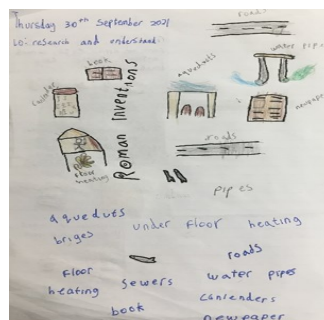
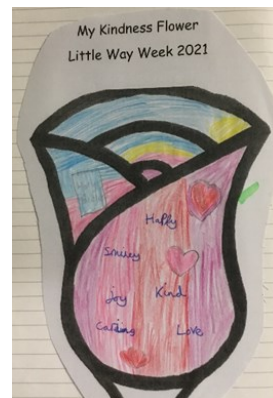
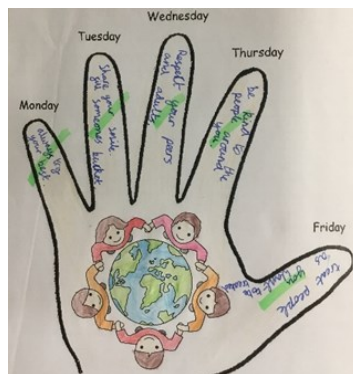
#HelloYellow this World Mental Health Day is a little thing we can do to make a BIG difference to young people's mental health.
