Breakfast Club

The entrance into Breakfast Club is our one-way system through the Staff car park (as is the current procedure for all children) therefore, there will be one 'drop' off time of 7.45am - 8.00am when a member of Breakfast Club staff will be outside to greet the children and walk them into the hall.
