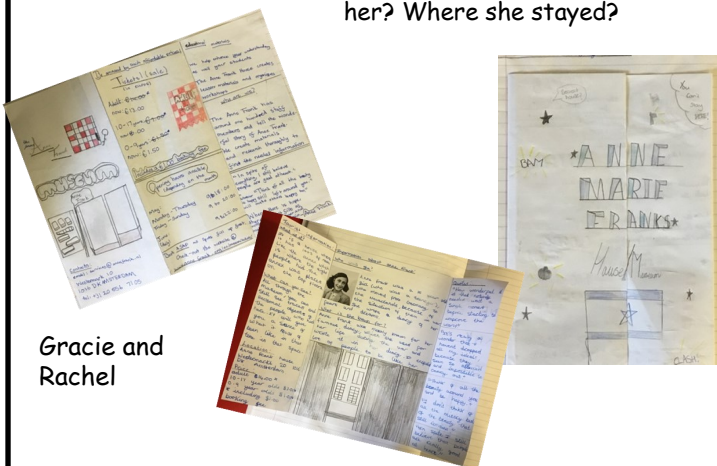
Monday is also Red, White and Blue non-uniform day; the children may wear one, two or all three colours.
