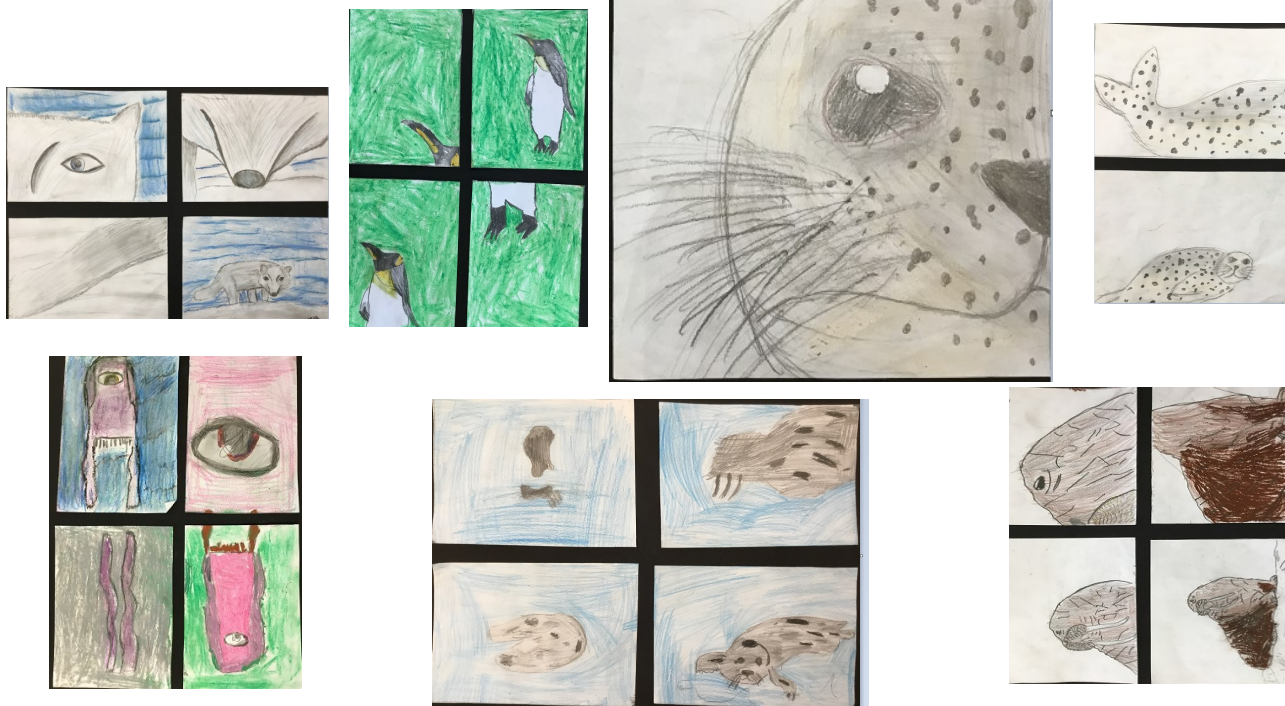
We are delighted to have had installed new scooter pods near the shelter on the playground. If it is helpful to families, the children are welcome to leave their scooters during the day.
