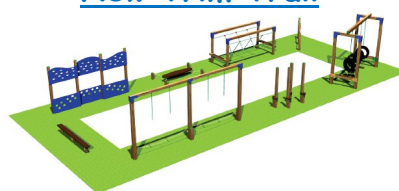
We will be displaying lost property out on the playground on Monday and Friday. Please look for your child's belongings.

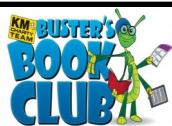
## World Autism Acceptance Week
