Class of the Week Year 1



This week in Year 1, we started reading a new story called 'Grandad's Island' by Benji Davis. We made predictions about what we think will happen in this story. Eliana predicted that the characters will go to a secret forest with animals based on the front cover. Rome predicted that the characters will go on Grandad's boat to go to a secret island.

The children are enjoying learning about their new topic Rio de Vida which means the River of Life. The children enjoyed making masks to start their new topic and taking part in a parade. We listened to music from Brazil and used instruments to repeat the rhythm and beat.



In Science, we are learning about plants. We are watching our plants grow and observing any changes. We have drawn observational drawings of a plant and labelled the parts of a plant. We are beginning to think about what the different parts of a plant are for.
