With our changeable weather, the winter uniform can also be worn during Term 5.


In Term 6 we ask that all children wear the 'summer' uniform.

We designed our own posters and tried to think of catchy slogans to go with them.




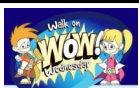
