Children In Need

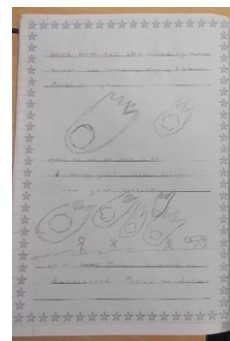
