Samson- "The Bayeux Tapestry shows the story of how William the Conqueror won."

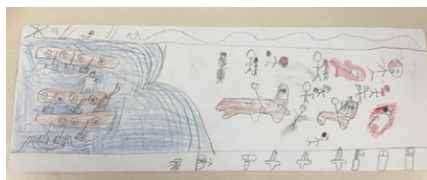
Sophia- "They sewed the tapestry because not many people knew how to read or write. People could follow the pictures like a comic book."
