NSPCC Number Day

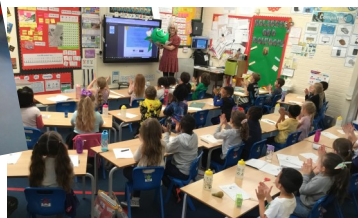
